(Correne Coetzer) Currently in Russia, Dimitri Kieffer will soon start the 6730 km / 4180 miles ninth stage of his human powered expedition around the world. He will be flying from Moscow to Yakutsk on May 23rd for the final preparations of his cycle through Russia, Mongolia, China and Kazakhstan. At first Dimitri will cover the first 2240 km (~1400 miles) alone between Yakutsk (Yakutia – Sakha Republic, Russia) and Chita (Zabaykalsky Krai, Far Eastern Russia). Thereafter his partner Gulnara Miftakhova plans to join...

Route map.

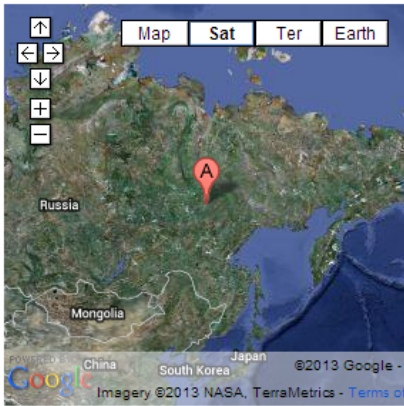
